## Wedgwood Local Rules

- 1. USGA rules govern all play except where local rules apply.
- 2. The embedded ball rule is in effect at all times except in a penalty area.
- 3. Markers:
- a) Out of bounds and penalty areas are defined by trees, lines, fences, or painted stakes to designate the penalty area, or O.B. area.
  Penalty for O.B. is Stroke and Distance.
- Stakes or lines defining penalty area or O.B. are considered to be in the penalty or O.B. area.
- 4. Relief exists from all blacktop paths and all dirt areas at the beginning and end of blacktop cart paths with the exception of the designated area behind the 13<sup>th</sup> green (see hole #13 rules). Relief exists on service roads on holes: 1, 2, 7, 8, 9 that exist outside the wooded areas. There is No relief from service roads in the woods. All other non-blacktopped paths are played as it lies!
- 5. Debris mounds and piles are considered ground under repair. There is no relief from un-spread grass clippings.
- 6. Swing relief exists for balls that come to rest near Stumps, guy wire, and pump houses, but only when those obstructions interfere with a players reasonable stance or swing. There is no line of site relief!
- 7. There is no relief from irrigation boxes. They are "integral" to the golf course.
- 8. There will be no allowance made for ignorance of the USGA or local rules. It is the sole responsibility of the player to know the rules and there proper interpretation.

## Rules by Hole

- Hole #1 O.B. left defined by trees, lines, fences, or painted stakes.
- Hole #2 O.B. left defined by trees, lines, fences, or painted stakes.
- Hole #3 O.B. left defined by trees, lines, fences, or painted stakes. Ball hitting telephone pole or electrical wire is considered "rub of the green". Storm water run-off pit area right of third fairway is considered a lateral penalty area.
- Hole #4 O.B. left, and behind green defined by trees, lines, fences, or painted stakes.
- Hole #5 O.B. left and behind green defined by trees, lines, fences, or painted stakes. Drainage area left past lake is considered a lateral penalty area. Drainage swale crossing the fairway is considered a penalty area. Storm water run-off pit area right of fifth fairway is considered a lateral penalty area. The bridge over the drainage swale area is considered to be in the penalty area and there is no relief.
- Hole #6 O.B. left defined by trees, lines, fences, or painted stakes. Drainage swale right side near woods is considered a penalty area.
- Hole #7 O.B. left defined by trees, lines, fences, or painted stakes.
- Hole #8 O.B. left defined by trees, lines, fences, or painted stakes.
- Hole #9 O.B. left, and behind green defined by trees, lines, fences, or painted stakes.
- Hole #10 -O.B. left defined by trees, lines, fences, or painted stakes.
- Hole #11 -O.B. left defined by trees, lines, fences, or painted stakes. Drainage swale running before, along, and past the green is considered a lateral penalty area. The area

## Rules by Hole Continued

inside the mounded collection area right, after the tree line, will be played as ground under repair. Ball may be dropped within 2 club lengths (no closer to the hole) of the water line, or silt line (whichever exists at the time of play).

- Hole #12 No local Rules in effect.
- Hole #13 Ditch running up the left side before the first lake is considered a lateral penalty area. O.B. left side after crossing 1st lake defined by trees, lines, fences, or painted stakes. Ball hit into first lake (penalty area) must be played from the side in which the ball entered the penalty area. Balls clearing the first lake (penalty area), but landing in second lake (penalty area, are played as a lateral penalty area. Balls hit over the second lake that land in the water (penalty area) will be played from the designated drop area. O.B. behind the green defined by trees, lines, fences, or painted stakes. Ball coming to rest behind the green between the barber poles indicating where the cart path is considered "integral" to the hole must be played as it lies, or dropped in the appropriate drop area with a one stroke penalty. The bridge between lake 1 and 2 is considered to be in the penalty area and there is no relief.
- Hole #14 -O.B. left defined by trees, lines, fences, or painted stakes. Ball hit into the 1<sup>st</sup> lake (penalty area) in front of the tee area must be replayed from the tee area. Balls hit into the 2<sup>nd</sup> lake in front of hole #13 (penalty area), shall be played as a lateral penalty area from the designated drop area on #13.
- Hole #15 -O.B. left, and behind green defined by trees, lines, fences, or painted stakes.
- Hole #16 No local Rules in effect.
- Hole #17 -O.B. left, defined by trees, lines, fences, or painted stakes.
- Hole #18 O.B. left, and behind green defined by trees, lines, fences, or painted stakes.
