



Dear Wedgwood Country Club Guest:

Thank you for booking your upcoming round of golf with Wedgwood Country Club. In preparation for your visit we would like to familiarize you with the policies and procedures we have put in place in order to meet state, local, and/or CDC best practices guidelines. While these procedures might be viewed as a nuisance, they represent necessary measures for WCC to protect its guests and staff, and to help WCC do its part in avoiding the possibility of a spike in COVID cases, and as such, a second shut down.

We thank you for your cooperation, and look forward to your visit with us.

Things you need to know or do:

1. If you have not already done so, please go to our website, [Wedgwoodcc.com](http://Wedgwoodcc.com), the GolfNow website, or call the pro shop and pre-book your round. **Do Not Just Show Up.** WCC will be using the practice of one golf cart per person, and as such, the total number of rounds per day will be based on the number of available golf carts and pull carts the club has at any given time. Daily rounds will be made available on a first come first served basis, and in order for you to assure yourself a time, you need to plan ahead.
- 1) Plan to show up at the club no earlier than 20 min. before your scheduled tee time. This will aid in avoiding large groups from gathering in any one area for any prolonged period of time.
- 2) If you need to enter the pro shop, or use the restrooms for any reason, you must wear a mask. Anyone unable to meet this requirement will not be able to enter the building(s). Restroom areas will be available, and we ask you to use them for their intended purpose as well as for the purposes of washing your hands before or after coming into contact with staff or other patrons.
- 3) Beverage and snack service shall be available
- 4) In preparation for your round, if you plan to hit balls at our range nets, or putt on the practice green, please do so by practicing the social distancing rule of staying at least 6 feet apart from those in your group as well as others. This same rule should be practiced throughout your round.
- 5) All players shall play with their own set of clubs. No sharing a bag.
- 6) The practice of one player per cart will increase cart traffic out on the course, we ask that you pay special attention, and abide by our cart path rules. Cart path only policies exist on all par 3's, and holes 3, 10, 11, 17, and 18. On all other holes, you may ride in the fairways until reaching the 4x4 post in the middle of the fairway. When reaching the post, we ask that you proceed to the cart path and remain on it until the next hole. Rangers shall be present to help in this regard, as well as to watch for any social distancing violations.

- 7) To further safeguard our efforts, there will be no ball washers, rakes, or trash cans on the golf course. Please place all trash generated during the round in the sweater basket behind the cart seat. For those walking, please place trash in your golf bag (to be disposed of later), or in the sweater basket of a fellow player's golf cart if one exists in your group.

#### AS IT PERTAINES TO PLAY

- 8) As there will be no rakes in any of the bunkers, you may play the ball as it lies or, place the ball in the bunker, without penalty.
- 9) Cups will have a device placed inside them to avoid the need to reach into the cup to retrieve your ball, or touch the flag. **All putting should be done with the flag in.** If the ball hits the stick or device, the ball is to be considered holed for scoring purposes.
- 10) All other rules of the game should be played as normal.

Upon completion of your round, we ask that you park your cart (or pull cart) in the designated return area, grab your clubs, proceed to your car, and exit the property without delay. This again will help with overcrowding of any one area.

We thank you in advance for doing your part to help WCC meet current social distancing requirements, and we look forward to the time these measures are no longer necessary and the game we love returns to normal.
